CRITERIA FOR THE ACCOLADES RECOGNITION PROGRAM

Accolades is a recognition program to honour significant contributions and/or achievements of Kawartha Pine Ridge (KPR) students, staff, and community members. The individuals and groups who meet the criteria will be recognized. When presentations are to be made, individuals will be honoured at a regular meeting of the Board. At that time, a brief rationale will be read by the Director of Education. KPR certificates of recognition will be presented by the Chairperson of the Board and the local trustee. The selection will be based on the pre-determined criteria listed below. People within the system and the community-at-large will be encouraged to make nominations. These nominations are to be made on the program form available on the website.

Please submit nomination forms to Linda Burton, Executive Liaison to the Trustees, during the first week of any month. Recipients will be contacted in advance, and notified of the presentation date.

CRITERIA

Students

Significant achievements at the municipal, provincial, national or international level, including: Noteworthy accomplishments in academics, sports, the arts, citizenship or leadership. This includes:

- 1st to 3rd place achievement at the local municipal or the provincial level in any of the areas identified above.
- 1st to 10th place at the national or the international level.
- Recommendation of the school principal as a result of special effort or accomplishment.

Staff

Significant achievements at the municipal, provincial, national or international level, including:

- Receipt of municipal, provincial, national or international awards.
- Development of initiatives that result in significant enrichment of the educational experience of students or colleagues or the advancement of public education.

Note: This does not include committee work, special projects, professional development, individual academic achievements or recognition for retirement or long service.

School Community

Significant contributions that have a positive impact on the quality of educational programs and/or the educational experience of students, including:

- Contributions that reinforce the Board's mission, student achievement or other components of the Strategic Priorities.
- Contributions resulting in positive promotion of KPR and public education.
- Initiation and development of partnerships that result in significant enrichment of students' educational experience or the effectiveness of the school district.
