

FiveCounties Checklist for Preschoolers - Age 3-

These activities are typical of a child who is 3 years old.

- ✓ Pencil Skills
- ✓ Grasps crayon between thumb and fingers
- ✓ Crayon begins to rest between thumb and index finger
- ✓ Copies horizontal line and circle
- ✓ Imitates cross
- ✓ Colours simple shapes
- √ Fine Motor Skills
- ✓ Cuts along a straight line
- Picks up a bead and moves it into the palm of the same hand
- ✓ Holds two objects in palm of hand and is able to release one
- √ Visual Motor Skills
- ✓ Matches pattern of 3-4 blocks
- ✓ Sorts according to colour
- ✓ Begins to identify same/different
- ✓ Identifies 10 body parts
- √ Feeding Skills
- ✓ Uses fork with little spillage
- ✓ Pours from a small cup
- √ Dressing Skills
- ✓ Pulls up a zipper
- ✓ Manages large buttons
- ✓ Removes elastic waist pants independently
- ✓ Puts on front opening shirt independently.

WATCH FOR THESE WARNING SIGNS

- Tires or gives up easily
- Explores objects with mouth
- Resists messy play (glue, fingerpaint)
- Does not reach across own body
- Avoids colouring or crafts
- Clumsy with small objects
